The "Field and Particles" division of the French Physics Society (SFP) organizes the annual Journées Jeunes Chercheurs (JJC) conference, to be held at Sète in the south of France, from December 7th until December 13th. The 2014 edition is supported by the CEA, IN2P3, and FRIF (Fédération de Recherche Interactions Fondamentales) research organizations.

This conference aims at gathering young researchers who are in their second or third year of PhD thesis, although first year PhD students as well as young post-doc researchers are welcome to participate. This conference is a very good opportunity for the participants to share their research work and get an overview of the latest research developments achieved in his/her field, within a nice and laid-back environment.

Resarch topics covered by the JJC 2014 conference are the following: astroparticle physics, physics beyond standard model, cosmology, instrumentation, electroweak standard model, neutrino physics, flavor physics. Presentations could either be given in english or french.

The conference social program foresees an half-day trip in the nearby area, as well as one or two public seminars.

Conference fees amount to 400 euros per participant. It includes registration fees a well as full board accommodation fees in double rooms at the Lazaret holiday inn (http://www.lazaretsete.com).

Transportation fares will be covered by each participant's research laboratory, excepting those concerning the arrival (December 7th at night) and departure shuttles (December 13th before noon).
